IMPORTANT NOTES:

1. For rounding up of premium or regular contributions, your donations will follow the premium payment term and frequency of your life policy. For example, premiums of your life policy need to be paid for the next 10 years every month; the rounding up of your premiums or regular contributions will also be made for the next 10 years every month.
2. If you were to change the frequency of your premium payments for your life policy, for example from monthly to yearly, your donation will also be changed accordingly, for example, \$1 per month to \$12 per year.
3. Donations will cease when your life policy lapses, matures, is surrendered, converted to a paid-up policy or when automatic premium loan is activated on your main life policy.
4. Donations through rounding up of premium or regular contributions will take effect on the next premium due date of your life policy and will have the same due date as your life policy. For new proposals, the donation will start from the next premium due date after the policy is issued.
5. By agreeing to donate to OrangeAid, you have given the consent for NTUC Income to disclose your particulars as necessary to our beneficiaries with IPC (Institutions of a Public Character) status for the purpose of issuing tax deductible receipt to you.
6. A donation receipt for the purpose of tax deduction will be issued by OrangeAid beneficiaries that have IPC status, provided that the following criteria are met:
 - a. Total donation of \$60 and above, for a period of 12 months from 1st October till 30th September of the following year; and
 - b. Donor's name, NRIC and residential address are given.
7. There is no refund for donations made.
