Established in 2010, Income OrangeAid was set up as Income Insurance's community development platform to support our purpose of offering financial protection that leaves no one behind. This underscores our commitment to put people first, including empowering underserved communities and championing causes in support of education for low-income families, seniors' well-being and environmental causes.

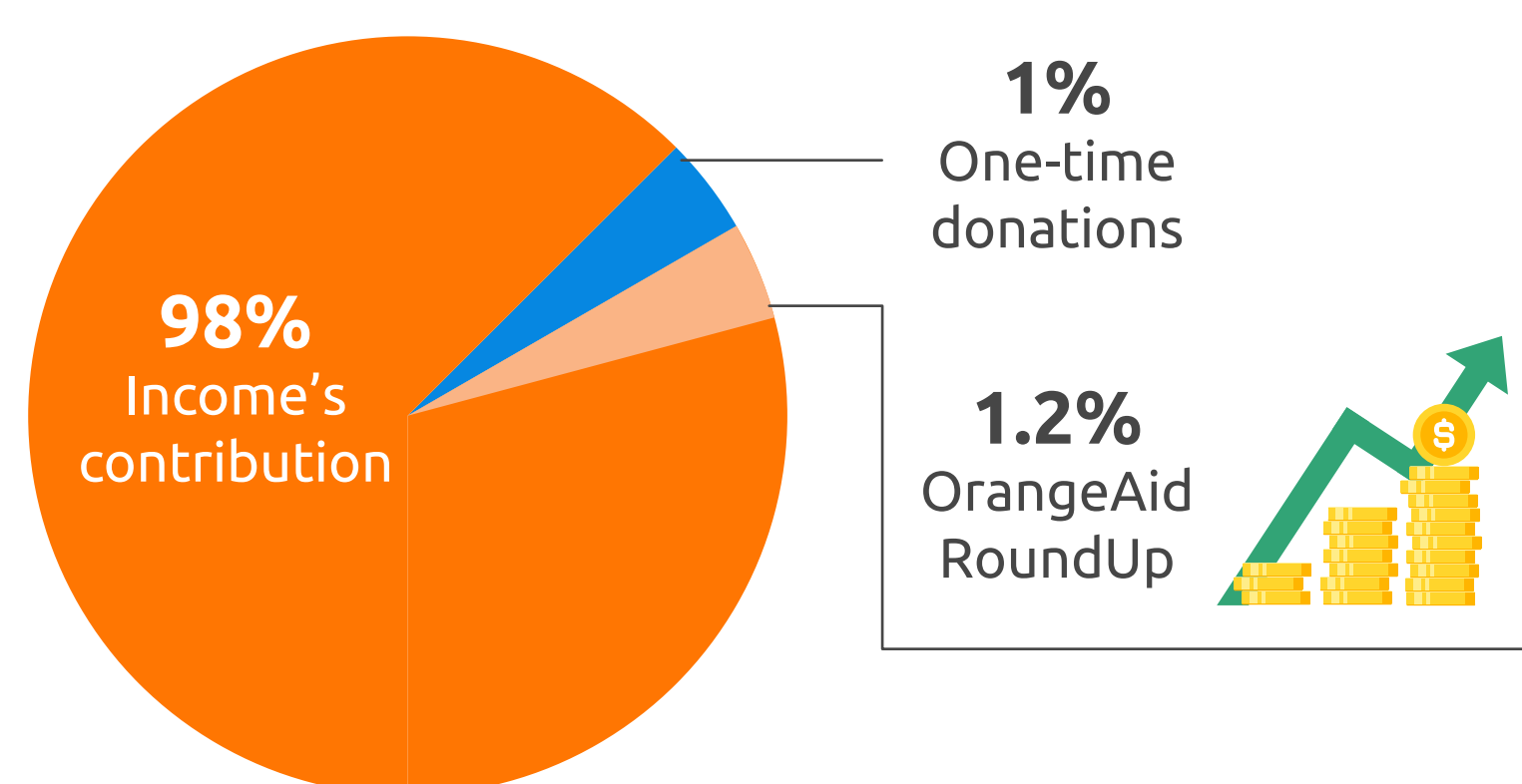
To amplify our commitment, we have pledged to contributing S\$100 million over a period of 10 years starting from 2021 via Income OrangeAid, to support these causes.

S\$36.9 million

disbursed to beneficiaries of Income OrangeAid since its inception in 2010 until 2022.

Channels of funding for 2022

To support our causes, we obtain funds via various channels. Majority of funds are contributions by Income Insurance, and the rest are via community support through one-time donations and OrangeAid RoundUp to support the Future Development Programme for low-income students.



How OrangeAid RoundUp works?

Our customers can opt to round up their life or general insurance policy premiums to the next dollar (or more) and donate the difference to the programme.

At Income Insurance, we believe education is essential in levelling the playing field for everyone in society. The donations received from donors go towards supporting low-income students via our flagship community initiative, the Income OrangeAid Future Development Programme (FDP).

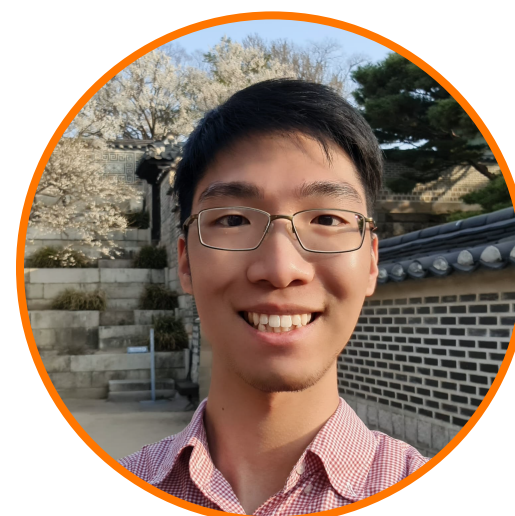
