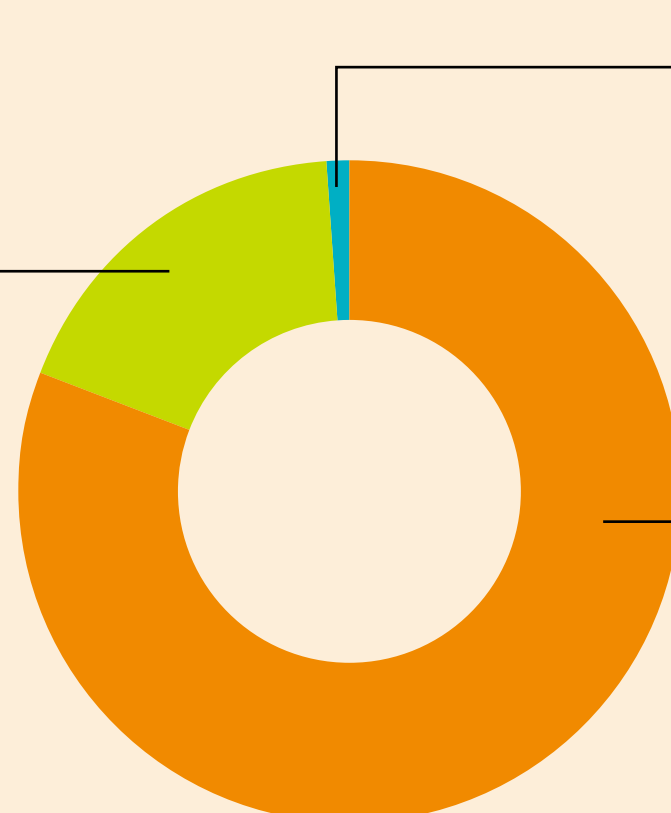


Income OrangeAid's Mission:

Established in 2010, Income OrangeAid aims to empower youth-in-need in Singapore through education. Income commits 1% of its annual insurance operating profits to fund OrangeAid programmes. LOW-INCOME INDIVIDUALS PROTECTED

by Income Family Micro-Insurance and Savings Scheme (IFMISS)

IFMISS is free for low-income families with young children studying at NTUC First Campus and those receiving help from the Ministry of Education Financial Assistance Scheme for Primary Schools. The Scheme offers a maximum pay-out of \$10,000 in the unfortunate event that the insured passes on or suffers total and permanent disability.



EMPLOYED 7 BARISTAS FROM MARGINALISED COMMUNITIES

Income OrangeAid's partnership with Betr Barista helps women and youth-at-risk cultivate their entrepreneurial spirit as coffee baristas as they see to daily set-up, operations, customer service and coffee sales at three Income OrangeAid Betr Barista Coffee Carts. In 2017, the coffee carts served over 35,000 customers and close to 44,000 coffees and teas. Betr Barista trains women and youth-at-risk for long-term careers in the specialty coffee industry via a certified professional coffee education, as well as, physical and emotional wellness programmes.



ENHANCED RESILIENCE AND VALUES AMONGST AT-RISK YOUTHS IN SPECIALISED SCHOOLS

OrangeAid supported values-in-action programmes in specialised schools such as Assumption Pathway School, Crest Secondary School and Spectra Secondary School. These programmes benefitted close to 2,000 students by providing them with knowledge and skills to enhance their resilience and cope better with their own adversities.
